On November 30, 2024, Plaintiff filed a motion for a preliminary injunction prohibiting Defendants from enforcing California Penal Code section 26202 against him and, by doing so, denying him issuance of a CCW license.

The Court, having considered Plaintiff's motion, finds good cause for issuance of the preliminary injunction that he requests, GRANTS his motion, and ORDERS as follows:

Defendants are prohibited from enforcing California Penal Code section 26202 against Plaintiff, namely, denying him issuance of a CCW license on the basis that a restraining order had been issued

1 against him. The Court finds that Plaintiff has satisfied all  
2 requirements for issuance of a CCW license and for that reason  
3 further ORDERS Defendants to issue him the CCW license that he  
4 applied for.
