19 } PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

20 On November 30, 2024, Plaintiff filed a motion for a preliminary
21 injunction prohibiting Defendants from enforcing California Penal
22 Code section 26202 against him and, by doing so, denying him
23 issuance of a CCW license.

24 The Court, having considered Plaintiff's motion, finds good cause
25 for issuance of the preliminary injunction that he requests, GRANTS
his motion, and ORDERS as follows:

26 Defendants are prohibited from enforcing California Penal Code
27 section 26202 against Plaintiff, namely, denying him issuance of a
28 CCW license on the basis that a restraining order had been issued

1 against him. The Court finds that Plaintiff has satisfied all
2 requirements for issuance of a CCW license and for that reason
3 further ORDERS Defendants to issue him the CCW license that he
4 applied for.
